

COOKIE POLICY

What is a Cookie?

Cookies are recorded, small text files, or information on your computer, or mobile device when you visit websites using mobile, or desktop devices. Cookies generally contain the names of sites they come from, their lifespan, and values formed by random given numbers.

What do we use cookies for?

We use cookies to make our site easier to use, to tailor it for your interests and needs, and for personalization to show our users smart advertisements. Websites can read and write the cookie files; and important information related to you can get recalled, so that you can get recognized, and get served a more suitable website (like recalling your preference settings).

Cookies also help in speeding up your future activity on our website. Additionally, we can use cookies to gather statistical information about the usage of our website, so that we can understand how our visitors use our website, and that we can improve our website's design and practicality.

We utilize cookies to personalize users' browsing of websites, mobile applications, and/or mobile websites.

This utilization contains;

The cookies that save your password and ensure that your website/mobile application/mobile website session stays constantly open, so that they save you from entering your password again for each visit

The cookies that remember and recognize users on their later visits to the website/mobile application and/or mobile website.

Also including the detection of how you used the website/mobile application/mobile website, from where the users connected to the website and/or mobile website, and which devices they used to connect, what content they looked at on the website/mobile application/mobile website, and the duration of their visit; we use cookies to determine how a user browses a website, mobile application and/or mobile website.

We use cookies to serve appropriate content and advertisements suited for the interests of the user, in other words, we use cookies for targeted advertisements or presentation.

What kind of cookies do we use?

We use two kinds of cookies called session cookies, and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary cookies, and last only until you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your device's internal storage until you delete them, or until they expire (in this way, how long cookies remain on your device, depends on their "lifespan").

Third-Party Cookies

In order for service providers who collect analytic information with our partners, advertisement platforms, and social media platforms, to present their services when you visit our websites, we may allow them to save cookies on your devices on behalf of us. In order to learn more about these cookies, and for detailed information on how to control these cookies, please go over the third party companies' privacy notices and cookie policies.

"www.themaestrohotel.com" cookies may also be used for; search engines, the "www.themaestrohotel.com" website, mobile application, or mobile website and/or for presenting you advertisements you may be interested in when you visit a website that "www.themaestrohotel.com" puts advertisements in. For this purpose; to provide you with special advertisements, the cookies use information regarding previous visits on the website, or the websites "www.themaestrohotel.com" puts advertisements in. While presenting the personalized advertisements, in order for "www.themaestrohotel.com" to recognize you, the cookies may put a unique third-party cookie on your browser.

If google analytics is used "www.themaestrohotel.com" also uses a web analysis service called Google Analytics, provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses cookies to analyze how a user browses the website, the mobile application and/or the mobile website, with statistical information/reports.

How can you control the cookies or delete them?

Many internet browsers are set to accept cookies automatically by default. You can change these settings to block cookies, or to warn when a cookie is sent to your device. There are multiple ways to control cookies. To learn detailed information about how you can change your browser's settings, please refer to your browser's instructions, or help screen.

Depending on the type of browser you use, you can follow the steps below to get information about cookies, to exercise your right to allow or disallow.

Google Chrome: By clicking the "lock symbol" on your "address section", or by clicking on the letter "i", from the "Cookie" tab you can allow or block cookies.

Internet Explorer: On the upper-right corner of your browser, click on the "Security" tab from the "Tool" or "Tools" section, and click on "allow" or "disallow" to manage your cookies.

Mozilla Firefox: Click on the "open menu" tab at the upper-right corner of your browser. Manage your cookies by clicking on the "options" image, using the "Privacy and Security" button.

Also, for other browsers (like Opera, Microsoft Edge), you can inquire on the browsers' help or support pages.

Safari: Click on the "Safari" tab from the "Settings" section of your phone, you can manage cookies from the "Privacy and Security" section.
